## Water restored to Bayonne

Bayonne residents have full water service restored according to the Bayonne Municipal Utilities Authority.

Bayonne spokesman Joe Ryan released this statement regarding the Bayonne water main break:

### Bayonne Water Notice

The entire City of Bayonne experienced an interruption in water service this morning from approximately 4:30 AM until approximately 6:45 AM. Apparently a 30-inch main on the city's main aqueduct failed most likely due to freezing temperatures.

BMUA employees responded to the scene, isolated the break and restored service.

The BMUA Emergency Services Contractor, Joseph Jingoli and Son, Inc. of Lawrenceville, NJ as well as the Authority's Engineers, Hatch Mott MacDonald of Milburn, NJ are en route to the scene to assess the situation and commence the necessary repairs.

The water supply is safe to drink and does not require boiling before use.
